

BY-LAW # 93-1

A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPELLING ALL PERSONS
TO REMOVE AND CLEAR AWAY ALL SNOW, ICE, DIRT AND
OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS FROM SIDEWALKS.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to provide for the removal of all snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions from the sidewalks within the Village of Acme, and

WHEREAS it is deemed proper pursuant of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, Section 186, that provisions be made for the clearing of sidewalks.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Acme, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That all persons within the Village of Acme are hereby compelled to remove all snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions from sidewalks situated on land adjoining the property owned or occupied by them.
2. The Village of Acme is hereby authorized to provide for the clearing of sidewalks adjoining the property of non-residents and all other persons who for 24 hours neglect to clear them, and in the case of non payment of expenses thereof by the owner or occupant, the expenses will be charged against the property as a special assessment to be recovered in a like manner as and with other taxes.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 26 DAY OF APRIL, 1993.
