BYLAW 2026-07
2026 PROPERTY TAX BYLAW**

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ACME FOR THE 2026 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Village of Acme has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of municipal revenue and expenditures as required, at the Council Meeting held on April 27th, 2026, and,

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than municipal property taxation total is estimated at **\$1,005,055** (operating) plus **\$3,104,350** (capital) = **\$4,109,405** including all transfers and grants expected and,

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required for current year municipal operating expenses and transfers (less property tax requisitions) set out in the budget for the Village of Acme for 2026 total **\$2,106,979** and,

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required for current year municipal capital expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the Village of Acme for 2026 total **\$3,104,350** and,

WHEREAS, the estimated total municipal operating and capital expenditures for the Village of Acme in 2026 total **\$2,106,979 + \$3,104,350 = \$5,211,329** and,

NOW THEREFORE, the total amount of **(\$5,211,329 - \$4,109,405) = \$1,101,924** is to be raised by general municipal taxation, and,

WHEREAS, the requisitions for 2026 are:
