Being a bylaw of the Village of Acme in the Province of Alberta, Canada **TO AMEND BYLAW 2025-04 COUNCIL PROCEDURAL BYLAW** in the Village of Acme.

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Government Act authorizes a municipality to pass a bylaw respecting service provided by or on behalf of the municipality including the power to amend the bylaw;



**NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY AMENDS BYLAW 2025-04 COUNCIL PROCEDURAL BYLAW SECTION 4.6 AS FOLLOWS:**

- 4.6 Council members available via teleconference or videoconference shall be considered part of the quorum. Council members participating via teleconference or videoconference shall be permitted to participate in any In-Camera meeting of council, providing they are alone in a private setting and are not recording.

**THIS BYLAW COMES INTO FORCE ON THE DATE OF THIRD READING.**

Read a first time this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2026.




