BY-LAW NUMBER 1-1979 of the VILLAGE OF ACME

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH HER MAJESTY, THE QUEEN, IN THE RIGHT OF ALBERTA (REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF THE ENVIRONMENT).

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 119 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970, (as amended), the Council may pass a By-law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the Council and the Province or its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and

WHEREAS under the Environment Grant Regulations the Minister of the Environment may enter into an agreement with a local authority to provide for any work or undertakings; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Acme has made application to the Minister of the Environment under the Alberta Municipal Sewer Assistance Program for financial assistance for a project relating to the installation of a lagoon in the M. D. of Kneehill.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mactime Mayor and the Municipal Administrator of the Village of Acme be and are hereby empowered to execute agreements similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A" between the said Village of Acme and the Minister of the Environment relating to the Alberta Municipal Sewer Assistance Program.

THIS BY-LAW given first, second and by unanimous consent third reading, and finally passed this 12th day of February A.D. 1979.
