

**VILLAGE OF ACME  
BYLAW # 2017-03**

**(To be known as the Bylaw to Amend the Addressing Bylaw of the VILLAGE OF ACME)**

Pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto:

**WHEREAS** Section 7(a) of the *Municipal Government Act* allows a Council to pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 58 (2) of the *Municipal Government Act* authorizes a municipality to require an owner or occupant of a building or a parcel of land to display the identification in a certain manner;

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council of the Village of Acme, duly assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS** as follows:

**Amendment to Section 3.2 of Bylaw 2016-12 as follows:**

The owner of a property which has access to a lane may, in addition to complying with section 3.1., cause a rear Address Number to be displayed when the property has a rear garage, or shed or fence.

This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon passing.


