CAO APPOINTMENT BYLAW

BYLAW #2019-14 BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, RESPECTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE POSITION OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act provides that a council must, by bylaw, establish the position of chief administrative officer;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act and other provincial statutes provide for certain duties, functions and powers of a chief administrative officer that are independent of the council;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act further provides that a council may assign additional duties, functions and powers, within municipal jurisdiction, to a chief administrative officer;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act further provides that where an enactment or bylaw requires or authorizes a municipality to do something but does not specify who in the municipality may do it, or when a municipality wishes to exercise its natural person powers, then the thing may be done or the natural person powers may be exercised by the chief administrative officer unless the council specifies otherwise;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Acme in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

To create a Bylaw to hire a Chief Administrative officer in the Village of Acme and may be referred to as the "Chief Administrative Officer Bylaw".

1. That Gary Sawatzky be and hereby is appointed the Municipal Administrator of the Village of Acme in the Province of Alberta.
 - That the said Gary Sawatzky shall carry out his duties in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, the appropriate Municipal Statutes and the instructions given him by any resolution of the Council
 - That Gary Sawatzky shall carry out his duties as outlined in the contract provided to him.

This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the day that it is given its third and final reading, passed by Council and signed in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*.


