BYLAW 2026-08
AMENDING BYLAW 2022-06**

Being a bylaw of the Village of Acme in the Province of Alberta, Canada **TO AMEND BYLAW 2022-08 RECORDS, RETENTION AND DISPOSITION BYLAW** in the Village of Acme.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act authorizes a municipality to pass a bylaw respecting service provided by or on behalf of the municipality including the power to amend the bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Acme deem it necessary to amend Bylaw 2022-08 Records, Retention and Disposition Bylaw to provide for update from FOIP to ATIA and POPA.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY AMENDS BYLAW 2022-08 RECORDS, RETENTION AND DISPOSITION BYLAW AS FOLLOWS:

The following section is hereby repealed:

2.9 **FOIP** – Freedom of Information of Privacy Act, RSA, 2000, c.F-25 as amended.

The following sections are hereby added:

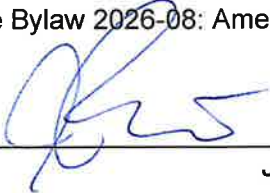
2.25 **ATIA** – Access to Information Act, Statute of Alberta, 2024 Chapter A-1.4 as amended.

2.26 **POPA** – Protection of Privacy Act, Statutes of Alberta, 2024 Chapter P-28.5.

Where bylaw 2022-06 references FOIP in Sections 2.5 and 8.3, each of these shall now be in reference to ATIA and POPA.

THIS BYLAW COMES INTO FORCE ON THE DATE OF THIRD READING.

Read a first time this 5th day of June, 2026.

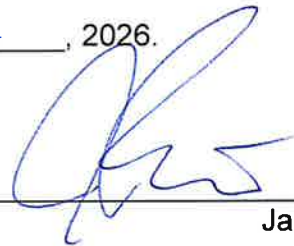
