

BY-LAW # 10-1981

A By-Law of the Village of Acme, in the Province of Alberta, to provide for the taking of votes of electors and proprietary electors by declaration and to rescind By-law # 14-1977.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Election Act being Chapter 245 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970, as amended, permits a council to pass a By-Law to provide that it is unnecessary to complete a list of electors.

NOW THEREFORE, the council fo the Village of Acme under the authority of Section 39.1 (1) of the Municipal Election Act (R.S.A. 1970) and amendments thereto, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That for the purpose of any election, by-election or vote on any question or by-law it is unnecessary to prepare a list of electors.

This by-law shall remain in effect until repealed.

Read a first time this 9, day of November 1981.

Read a second time this 9, day of November 1981.

Read a third time and finally passed this 9<sup>th</sup>, day of November 1981.
