

BY-LAW # 8 - 89 OF THE VILLAGE OF
ACME AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES
FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AN FCSS COMMUNITY
RESOURCE COUNSELLOR PROGRAM.

WHEREAS The Family and Community Support Services Act and Regulations thereunder, being Chapter F-1 of the Statutes of the Province of Alberta, and amendments thereto, provides that a Council may authorize a COMMUNITY RESOURCE COUNSELLOR PROGRAM under the Family and Community Support Program.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Acme in the Province of Alberta has agreed to enter into an agreement with the M.D. of Kneehill and the Towns of Three Hills and Trochu, and the Villages of Carbon, Torrington and Linden whereby the municipalities will in cooperation with the Province of Alberta and the Three Hills School Division establish and FCSS program to operate in the M.D. of Kneehill and the said urban municipalities.

for the singular purpose of providing a COMMUNITY RESOURCE COUNSELLOR PROGRAM for the people of the area.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor and Municipal Administrator are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the M.D. of Kneehill and the Towns of Three Hills and Trochu, and the Villages of Linden, Carbon and Torrington, to establish a community resource counsellor program.

ON CONDITION the 20% costs payable by the municipalities will be charged out on a per capita basis using current population figures, and further on condition that the F.C.S.S. program will be set up to provide only a community resource counsellor program for the people of this area and the program will not be expanded beyond the limits initially established by Council.

Councillor Martin moved first reading to this by-law.

Councillor Hannah moved third reading be given to this by-law at this time.

Mayor Kesler moved third reading be given to this by-law.
