BYLAW TO REPEAL BYLAW

A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING A BYLAW NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

1.1 This Bylaw repeals the following Village of Acme Bylaw:


1.1.1 Bylaw #2018-11 and all amendments thereto;

READ a first time this 9th day of December 2019.




