

BY-LAW #5-87

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ACME IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE M.D. OF KNEEHILL #48 TO GIVE ACCESS OF M.D. OF KNEEHILL RESIDENTS TO THE ACME TRANSFER BOX SITE AND FOR THE M.D. TO PAY 50% OF THE ANNUAL COST OF OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 113 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 Chapter M-26 (as amended) the Council may pas a by-law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Council of another municipality to benefit both respective municipalities.

WHEREAS, the Village of Acme and the M.D. of Kneehill #48 wish to enter into a joint agreement to give residents of the M.D. of Kneehill access to the transfer box site operated by the Village of Acme.

It is hereby understood and agreed that the M.D. of Kneehill would agree to pay 50% of the annual operation and normal maintenance costs incurred by the Village for the operation of the site.

NOW THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE OF ACME COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

The the Mayor and Municipal Administrator of the Village of Acme are hereby enpowered to enter into an agreement with the M.D. of Kneehill #48 to allow rural residents access to the Village of Acme transfer box.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 15th DAY OF JUNE, 1987.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 15th DAY OF JUNE, 1987.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 15th DAY OF JUNE 1987.
